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Solar modules and solar panels refer to essentially the same component of a photovoltaic system - the unit that converts sunlight into electricity. The term “solar module” is the precise, industry-standard name for a single PV unit, as used in certifications, standards, and technical literature.

Let’s start by understanding why individual solar cells are interconnected to form a solar module. A single solar cell, such as a crystalline silicon type, produces only a small voltage and current—typically an open-circuit voltage (Voc) of 0.55 to 0.72 V at 25°C, and a short-circuit current (Isc).

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
