Overview

How are electricity prices set in Bulgaria?

Based on supply and demand, prices are set for each hour and each area, one day in advance. Some countries, such as Norway, are divided into several different price areas, each of which has its own spot price. Electricity spot prices in Bulgaria today, hour by hour. Including prices for the last 30 days.

What is the standard electricity supply in Bulgaria?

Bulgaria's standard electricity supply is 220/230 volts AC with a frequency of 50 hertz. For other equipment, a transformer or adaptor is required unless the appliance has a multi-voltage option. Sockets in Bulgaria take standard European-style two pin plugs. The standard light bulb fitting in Bulgaria is a screw fitting.

How is the Bulgarian electricity market regulated?

The Bulgarian electricity market is regulated by national laws and policies, which align with European Union directives and regulations. Efforts have been made to liberalize the market, allowing for greater competition and private sector involvement, which is expected to lead to more competitive pricing and improved service quality.
