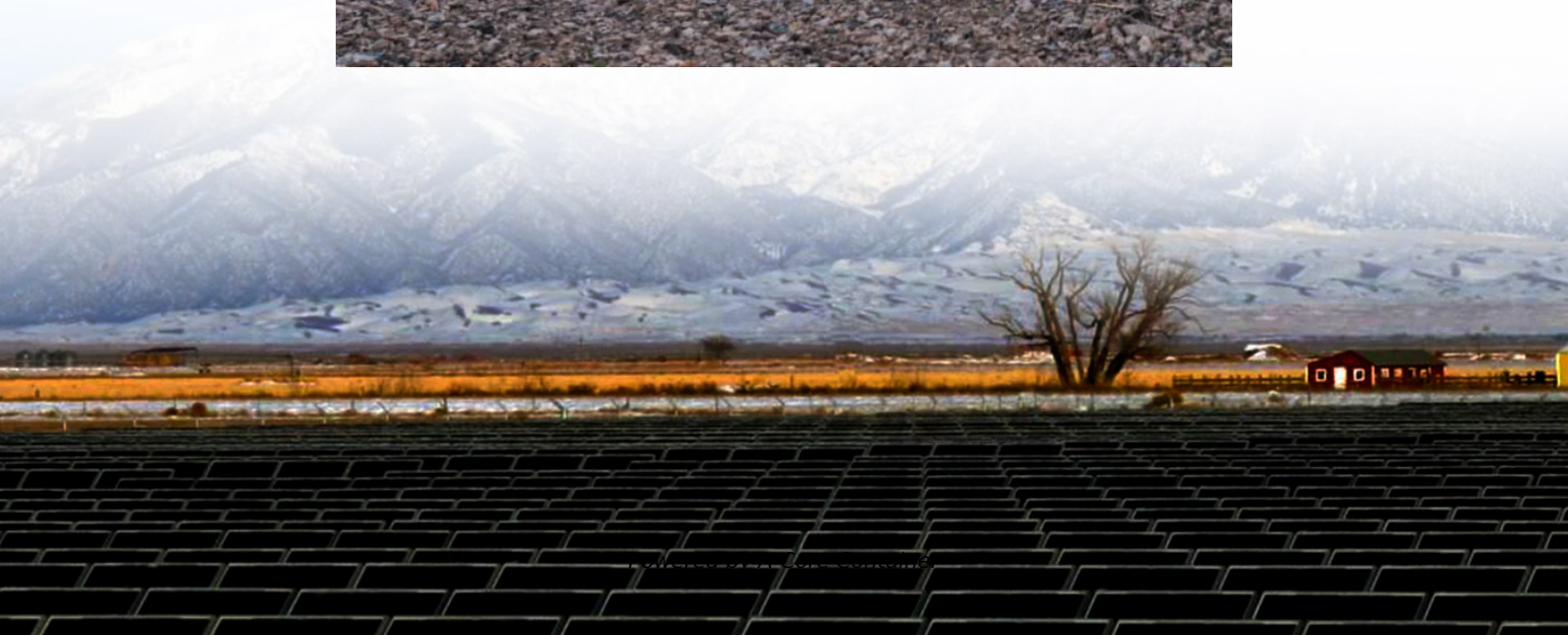

Burkina Faso exports solar panels



Overview

Burkina Faso's transitional parliament has approved a conventional loan agreement worth €45.7 million from the Export-Import Bank of China. The debt will finance the construction of the Donsin solar power plant and its electricity storage system. At a time when Burkina Faso is at a turning point in.

In a groundbreaking step toward a sustainable future, Burkina Faso has inaugurated West Africa's first solar panel factory, the Faso Energy Solar Panel Factory. This state-of-the-art, \$50 million facility is set to produce 200,000 solar panels annually. It promises to enhance the country's energy.

The Sustainable Energy Fund for Africa (SEFA), managed by the African Development Bank has committed a €6 million concessional finance package for the development of the 18 MW Dédougou Solar Power Plant in Burkina Faso, marking a significant milestone towards increasing the country's energy.

Burkina Faso has received a US\$48 million boost from the Export-Import Bank of China to aid in the development of the Donsin solar power plant project and its accompanying electricity storage system. The project involves the construction of a 25 MW solar power plant at the Donsin airport site.

Once heavily reliant on electricity imports, Burkina Faso is now embracing solar energy as a strategic pillar of its development. By harnessing the sun, the country aims to reduce its dependency, attract private investment, and

build a sustainable energy future. Until recently, nearly 40% of.
