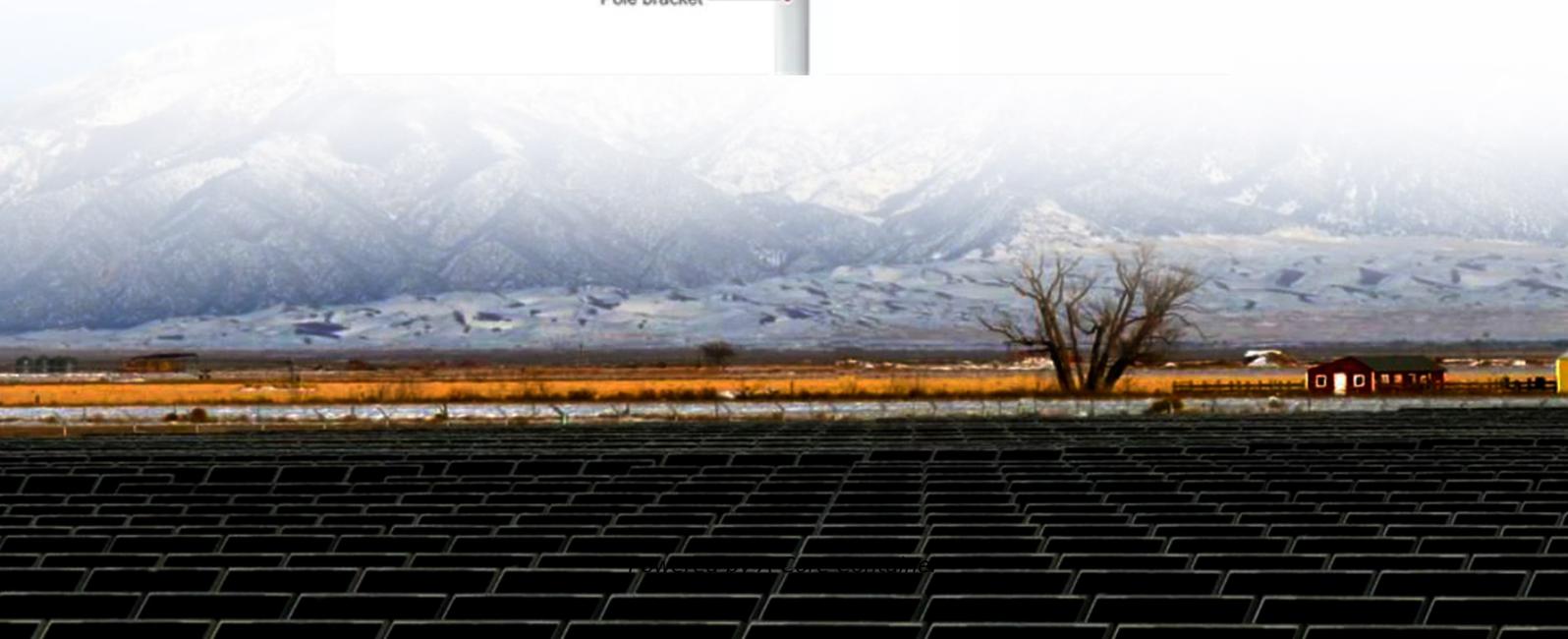


A-Core Container

Container power generators are available with a rated capacity of 30 kVA to 3000 kVA. Depending on the asked performance and execution, the generators are mounted in soundproof, weatherproof ISO container with a length of 10', 20' or 40'.

What size container do I need for my Generator?

What is included in a container generator?

The container generators are fully operational supplied, including air-intake, exhaust system and silenced muffler, tank, control panel and accessories such as lighting and fire extinguishers. Apart from the preparations for the load connection no further construction work at site is necessary.

Can you put a generator in a container?

Generators can be put into containers. There are a number of benefits to doing this including: Easier transportation and installation making them ideal for temporary or remote applications. They are more secure as typically they are lockable which prevents unauthorised access. Do I need to service my power system?
