What will the Czech electricity storage scheme do in 2025?

In an announcement released on March 7, 2025, the executive arm of the European Union said that the Czech scheme will support the installation of at least 1.5 GWh of new electricity storage facilities. The measure will be open to all storage technologies directly connected to the transmission network or distribution network.

Is there a future for energy storage in the Czech Republic?

Despite the ongoing discussions, there is no significant development in the area of energy storage. In 2015, the Czech Government adopted the National Action Plan for Smart Grids ("NAPSG") prepared by the Ministry of Industry and Trade under principles set out in the update of the State Energy Concept, which was also introduced in 2015.

How does the Czech government subsidise photovoltaic panels?

The Czech government subsidises the installation of photovoltaic panels

located on domestic properties producing energy for their own consumption and the purchase of co-located energy storage solutions. These subsidies are provided under the “New Green Savings Programme” administered by the State Environmental Fund.

How much does battery storage cost in Europe?

The landscape of utility-scale battery storage costs in Europe continues to evolve rapidly, driven by technological advancements and increasing demand for renewable energy integration. As we've explored, the current costs range from €250 to €400 per kWh, with a clear downward trajectory expected in the coming years.
