Financial power trading in Europe takes place on the Nasdaq exchange in Stockholm. Market participants use Nasdaq for price hedging and to trade in long-term products and derivatives. Norway is part of a joint Nordic power market with Sweden, Denmark, and Finland, which in turn is integrated into.

Statnett, Norway's transmission grid operator, recently announced a revised forecast for the nation's power supply and demand. The new report suggests that Norway's electricity surplus will now continue until 2028, pushed back from the originally projected 2027 due to slower growth in power demand.
