Estonia s large-capacity battery energy storage



Overview

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The Baltic Storage Platform joint venture – bringing together French independent solar power producer Corsica Sole, Estonia's leading renewable energy developer Evecon, and Mirova, an affiliate of Natixis Investment Managers dedicated to sustainable investment – has successfully secured €85.6.

The flagship battery storage project commenced operations on February 1, only days before cutting ties with the Russian power grid. Estonian state-owned energy company Eesti Energia has inaugurated the nation's largest battery energy storage facility at the Auvere industrial complex in Ida-Viru.

Baltic Storage Platform JV—a French-based independent solar power company, Corsica Sole, and Estonian major renewable energy developer Evecon, alongside Mirova, a group of the Natixis Investment Managers that specializes in sustainable investments—managed to finance the two battery energy storage.

A unique 400 MWh battery complex is taking shape in Estonia, marking one of Europe's largest energy storage projects. When it comes to energy, compact Estonia thinks big. The country, aiming for a full-fledged green transition, is
