State-owned utility and power generator Eesti Energia has completed and put into commercial operation the first large-scale BESS in Estonia. Eesti Energia officially inaugurated the 26.5MW/53.1MWh battery energy storage system last week (26 March), located at the Auvere industrial power plant.
