There are 147 energy storage projects under construction in Europe, with a total capacity of 14 GW, according to the European Energy Storage Inventory, launched by the European Commission. The European Energy Storage Inventory comprises operational, under construction, permitted, and announced.

The aim of the European Energy Storage Inventory is to record all European energy storage projects by status – in operation, planned and under construction –, by location and by technology. Most projects have been recorded in Germany so far. The dashboard can be filtered by country, project status.

The ninth edition of the European Market Monitor on Energy Storage (EMMES) by the European Association for Storage of Energy (EASE) and LCP Delta, is now available, highlighting Europe's rapid expansion in energy storage capacity, which reached 89 gigawatts (GW) by the end of 2024. The European Commission officially introduced the “European Energy Storage Inventory” at the beginning of March 2025-a pioneering real-time dashboard, which for the first time enables a comprehensive and transparent overview of the energy storage landscape in Europe. This innovative tool.
