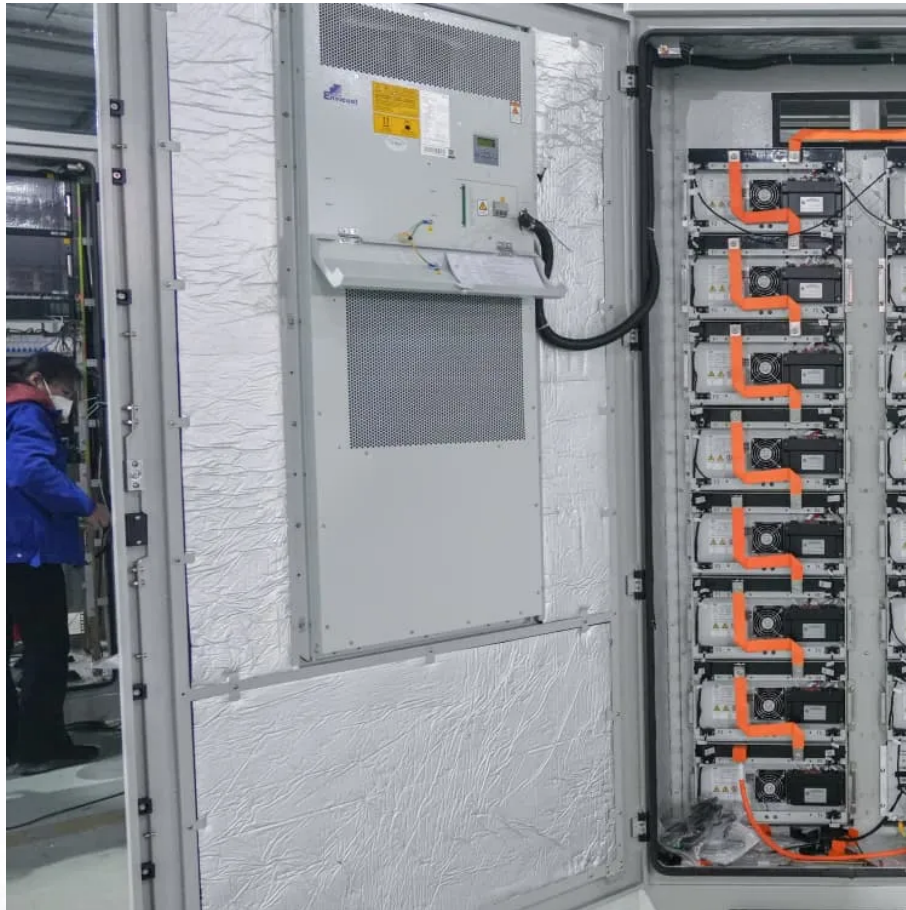

How much does it cost to install a set of solar panels



Overview

Solar panels generate “free” electricity, but installing a system still costs money. A typical American household needs a 10-kilowatt (kW) system to adequately power their home, which costs \$28,241 in 2025. That price effectively drops to \$19,873 after considering the full federal solar tax credit.

The average cost of installing a 7.6kW solar system on your roof is \$23,100 before any incentives or tax credits, and most homeowners pay somewhere between \$19,100 and \$23,800. Prices vary widely based on factors like the size of the system you need, the quality of the equipment you choose, how you.

Solar panel installation cost averages \$27,178, with most homeowners paying between \$18,356 and \$36,405. Your price depends on system size, panel type, and labor. Solar panel installation means adding a photovoltaic (PV) energy system to your home, mounted on your roof or property. System size.

Solar panels cost \$3.00 to \$4.50 per watt installed on average, with

One of the biggest cost factors for your solar panel installation is the size of the system you have installed. System size is measured in kilowatts (kW) and is determined by household energy consumption. The average cost per watt is \$3.04, but larger systems often have a lower cost per watt.

How much does a solar system cost?

If you just need a few panels for a small do-it-yourself solar project, expect to pay around \$200 to \$350 per panel (between \$0.80 and \$1.40 per watt). Note: The table below doesn't include the cost of a solar storage battery, which can add anywhere from \$7,000 to \$18,000 to your total solar system costs.

How much do commercial solar panels cost?

Generally, installing solar panels on businesses costs a bit less per watt because the systems are larger, but the total costs will be higher. In 2025, the average cost for commercial solar panels is just about \$2.00 per watt. There is a lot to consider when figuring out how much you'll spend on a solar installation.

When you install solar yourself, you don't have to pay labor costs, customer acquisition costs, or installer profit margins. However, installing solar panels is dangerous, and taking the DIY route can void your warranties and even prevent you from connecting to the grid. How do you calculate the cost of a solar system?

Solar panel costs are usually measured in the cost per watt of solar installed. However, solar system sizes are measured in kilowatts (kW). To calculate the total price of installing a home solar system, you'll need the system size to be in watts. To convert kilowatts to watts, all you need to do is multiply the system size in kW by 1,000.
