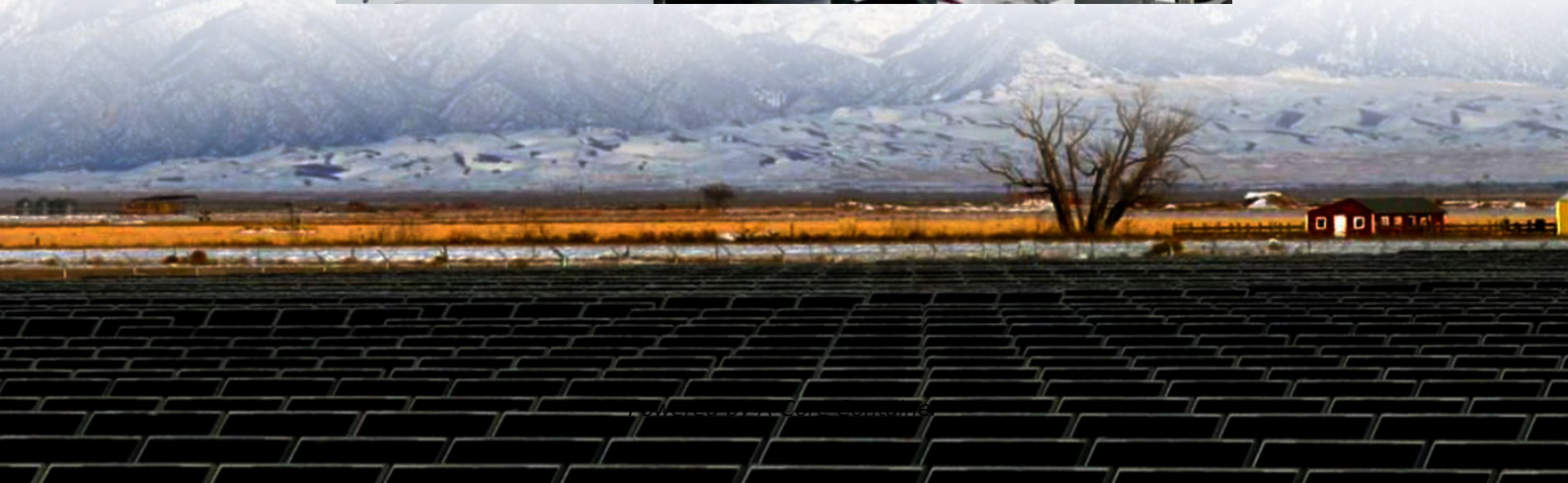

# Huawei s communication base station inverter facilities share in China



## Overview

How many 5G base stations does Huawei have?

The contracts have been split into two projects, with the first covering 63,800 base stations using 2.6GHz to 4.9GHz spectrum, while the second covers 23,141 in the 700MHz band. Huawei is estimated to have secured 45,426 5G base stations worth an estimated 4.1 billion yuan (US\$574 million).

Does Huawei have a strong market share?

According to the report, Huawei continues to lead the global market for the ninth consecutive year with a market share of 38.93%, making Huawei the only equipment manufacturer to maintain positive market share growth during this period.

Does Huawei support audio?

How much money did Huawei make in 2022?

Privately-held Huawei reported a total of 642.3 billion yuan in sales for the full year 2022, representing slim 0.9 per cent growth from 636.8 billion yuan in 2021. After a 5G buildout frenzy over the past four years, "China's 5G infrastructure development has already slowed and passed its peak", Yang said.

Is Huawei a sustainable company?

Huawei is the first in the industry to launch eco-friendly, high efficiency and green antennas, leading the industry's transition to sustainable development.

How many base stations does China have?
