The 20MWAC Golomoti Solar project with a 5MW/10MWh lithium-ion battery energy storage system (BESS) in Malawi has secured finance from InfraCo Africa and its project partner JCM Power. The Global Energy Alliance for People and Planet (GEAPP), in partnership with Malawi's government and ESCOM, has launched a \$20 million project to build the country's first Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) in Lilongwe. The initiative aims to cut carbon emissions by 10,000 tons annually while. Who owns the solar power plant in Malawi?

The plant was developed by JCM Solar Corporation and is co-owned by JCM Power and InfraCo Africa. Civil works on the solar plant began in early 2021 and were completed in December of the same year. The plant sells the electricity to the Electricity Supply Corporation of Malawi (ESCOM).

What is the Malawi Bess project?

The Malawi BESS project will guide the scale-up of BESS projects in the Consortium's participating countries. To alleviate energy poverty by 2030 and save a gigaton of CO₂ in low and middle-income countries, it is estimated that 90 GW of BESS must be developed to support the required 400 GW of renewable energy.

How can Malawi achieve a cleaner energy future?

The project will also contribute to a cleaner energy future for Malawi, reducing reliance on costly diesel generators, cutting carbon emissions by ~10,000 tonnes annually, and unlocking the full uptake of at least 100 MW of variable renewable energy, such as solar and wind power, into the grid.

Is Malawi a proof point for geapp's Bess project?

By breaking ground for this BESS project (and its subsequent completion expected in 2025), Malawi is an important proof point for the BESS Consortium launched by GEAPP at COP28 to secure 5 gigawatts (GW) of BESS commitments in low and middle income countries (LMICs) by the end of 2024.
