What is Mexico's largest solar project?

It will be the largest solar project built by Mexico's state-owned electric company. In Puerto Peñasco, near the top of the Gulf of California and border with Arizona, rows of solar panels that tilt with the passing sun run off to the horizon hovering above the sand.

Will Mexico's solar energy project go faster?

"It has to go faster." In April, Mexico plans to power up the first phase of a huge solar energy project near a beach town popular with tourists making the short drive from the United States. Once completed, the full \$1.6 billion project will have a generating capacity of 1,000 megawatts — enough to power some 500,000 homes.
