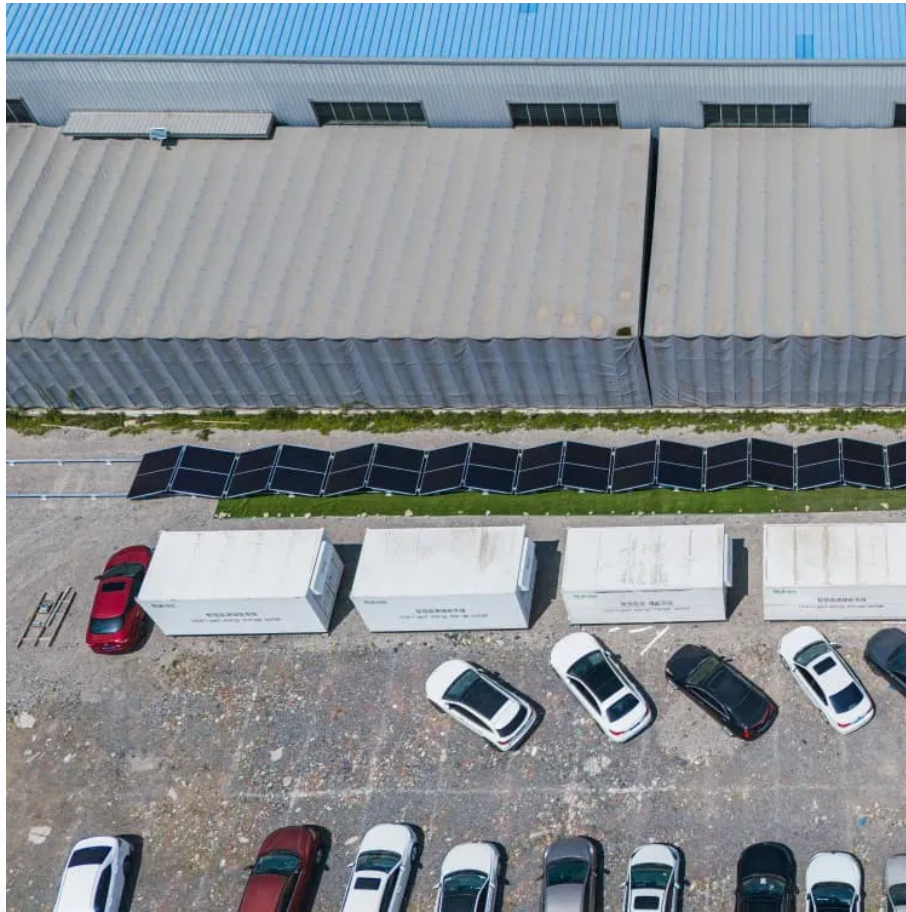

Operator Profiles: Myanmar's telecom market is dominated by four major mobile operators: Myanmar Post Telecommunications (MPT), Atom Myanmar (formerly Telenor), Ooredoo Myanmar, and Mytel. Competition is fierce, with over 95% 4G population coverage achieved.

When did MyTel become a telecommunication operator in Myanmar?

On 12 January 2017, Mytel (Telecom International Myanmar Co., Ltd.) received a license for the provision of telecommunication services, officially becoming the 4th operator in Myanmar. Bids were offered for two fresh telecom licenses by the Myanmar government. The deadline was set to be 8 February 2013.

Does Myanmar have a telecommunications market?
