Qatar family lithium battery pack



Overview

Does Qatar Airways allow lithium batteries in carry-on luggage?

Qatar Airways permits lithium batteries in carry-on luggage only, adhering to international aviation safety standards. Passengers can bring devices like laptops (up to 100 Wh) and limited spare batteries (under 160 Wh). All batteries must be individually protected to prevent short circuits.

Can I bring a battery to Qatar Airways?

Batteries between 100 Wh and 160 Wh: These require airline approval. Passengers planning to bring such batteries must inform Qatar Airways in advance and may need to present additional documentation. Batteries exceeding 160 Wh: These batteries are not allowed in either carry-on or checked luggage.

Can you carry lithium batteries on a plane?

Passengers are only allowed to carry spare lithium batteries in their carry-on baggage, and the batteries must have a maximum watt-hour rating of 100 Wh (watt-hours) or 2 grams of lithium content. Passengers are also required to take certain precautions when carrying lithium batteries.

How many Spare lithium ion batteries can I carry?

About spare batteries - you may carry a maximum of one spare lithium ion battery with a Wh rating not exceeding 300 Wh, or a maximum of two spare lithium ion batteries, each with Wh rating not exceeding 160 Wh. Please make sure that the removed batteries are properly packed in order to prevent short-circuiting or damage.

Are lithium batteries allowed in checked luggage?

Batteries exceeding 160 Wh: These batteries are not allowed in either carry-on or checked luggage. Lithium batteries are not permitted in checked luggage, as this is seen as a safety risk. If you have devices powered by

lithium batteries (such as cameras or laptops), ensure they are safely packed in your carry-on bag.

What are PEDs & pmeds containing lithium batteries?

PEDs & PMEDs containing lithium batteries include consumer electronics, video cameras, power tools, portable oxygen concentrators (POC), automated external defibrillators (AED), continuous positive airway pressure (CPAP) and any equipment containing lithium cells or batteries, which provide electrical power for operation.
