Overview

Generation of electricity started end of the 19th century by the construction of small-scale hydroelectric power plants. In the first half of the 20th century, the electricity sector was in hands of private companies, which built local and regional supply schemes. The first high-voltage power line of 69 kV was built for the power supply of Caracas when the hydroelectric power plants of Curupao and Izcaragua went into service in 1932.
