As of 2025, the average cost of solar panels in New York is \$3.30 per watt, making a typical 6.9 kilowatt (kW) solar system \$16,632 after claiming the 30% federal solar tax credit now available. This is higher than the average price of residential solar power systems across the United States, which.

For homeowners in New York, the average cost for a professionally installed residential rooftop solar system typically ranges from \$19,000 to \$35,000 before any tax credits or incentives are applied. This guide will provide a comprehensive breakdown of what that investment includes, the key factors. How much do solar panels cost in New York?

As of January 2025, the average solar panel system costs \$2.92/W including installation in New York. For a 5 kW installation, this comes out to about \$14,608 before incentives, though prices range from \$12,417 to \$16,799. After the federal tax credit, the average price drops by 30%. You'll probably pay even less than what we show here.

How much does solar cost per square foot?

The average system cost only drops by \$1,000 and the cost per square foot increases to \$12.83. Installing less solar will lower your cost but on a non-linear basis as there are a lot of fixed costs for installers to design, permit, and

install your system.

How much does a solar system cost in 2025?

Solar panels generate “free” electricity, but installing a system still costs money. A typical American household needs a 10-kilowatt (kW) system to adequately power their home, which costs \$28,241 in 2025. That price effectively drops to \$19,873 after considering the full federal solar tax credit.

How much does a solar system cost per watt?

As of publishing, the average cost per watt is \$2.84. Most solar companies set the price according to the solar system's wattage. A solar installation's “cost per watt” is a little like the “price per square foot” when you buy a house. It helps compare the value of solar energy systems in different sizes.

How much does a monocrystalline solar panel cost?

Monocrystalline solar panels cost between \$1 and \$1.50 per watt, are highly efficient, durable and last up to 30 years. Polycrystalline solar panels cost between \$0.70 and \$1 per watt and are slightly less efficient and durable. They also last up to 30 years.

What is the relative cost of solar energy?

Another measure of the relative cost of solar energy is its price per kilowatt-hour (kWh). Whereas the price per watt considers the solar system's size, the price per kWh shows the price of the solar system per unit of energy it produces over a given period of time. Net cost of the system / lifetime output = cost per kilowatt hour
