Is Tshwane reviving plans to upgrade its power station?

According to the Department Of Mineral Resources And Energy's 2022 Gas Master Plan, the City of Tshwane was planning to revive plans to lease and upgrade its power station with the aim of transforming the feedstock usage from anthracite (a grade of coal that is more profitable to export) to fossil gas.

How much does Pretoria spend on staff salaries?

According to reporting from September 2023, the city was spending R300 million a year on staff salaries and maintenance at the mothballed Pretoria West power station and Rooiwal power station.

Where is low and intermediate waste disposed of in South Africa?

Low and intermediate waste is disposed of at Vaalputs Radioactive Waste Disposal Facility in the Northern Cape. As of 2023, South Africa has 37

operating wind farms with a total installed capacity of about 3,560 MW. The Department of Energy (DOE) implemented the Renewable Energy Independent Power Producer Procurement Programme (REIPPPP).
