What is a solarcontainer?

The Solarcontainer is a photovoltaic power plant that was specially developed as a mobile power generator with collapsible PV modules as a mobile solar system, a grid-independent solution represents. Solar panels lay flat on the ground. This position ensures maximum energy harvest. Panels lay flat on the ground.

What is a solar panels on shipping container?

It not only transports the PV equipment, but can also be deployed on site. It is based on a 10 - 40 foot shipping container. Efficient hydraulics help get the solar panels ready quickly. Due to its construction, our solar panels on shipping container offers unmatched flexibility and maneuverability.

How many households can a solar Container Supply?

Based on an average power consumption of a 4-person household of 4000 kWh per year and a location in Southern Germany, the solar container can supply approx. 32 households with climate-friendly electricity. At a location in Southern Europe it can even be up to 50 households due to the high solar radiation.

How many installers does a solarcontainer need?

At least 3-4 installers and 1 crane operator are needed to put the Solarcontainer into operation within one day. How many households can one Solarcontainer supply with electricity?

How long does it take to ship a solar container?

Standard solar container models can be manufactured and ready to ship in as little as 4-6 weeks. Customized configurations can take up to 8-10 weeks, with

shipping times varying by destination. Do you offer after-sales support for mobile solar PV containers?
